Chandigarh, dated the 17-10-2018

Chandigarh Administration had notified the amendment in Rule 193 of Chandigarh Motor Vehicle Rules, 1990 removing the exemption given to all women from wearing the protective headgear while driving/ riding two-wheeler on the road and substituting the same by "Sikh Person (including Women) wearing a turban." Howsoever many Sikh Bodies have made representations to the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India against this notification with a plea that all Sikh Women should be kept exempted from the ambit of this notification irrespective of the fact whether they wear a turban or not. Now Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India has issued an advisory to the Chandigarh Administration to follow Delhi pattern where for Sikh Women wearing a protective headgear (helmet) while driving or riding a two wheeler is optional. Accordingly, Chandigarh Administration intends to initiate a public consultation process to elicit suggestions / objections from stakeholders / NGOs and concerned citizens so that a final view may be taken on the issue.
