Chandigarh, the 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2011

**No. 2/3/1-41117-2011/12256** Pursuant to Rule 50 of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989 as notified by the Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways vide gazette notification no. No.221(E) dated 28.03.2001 and SO No.814(E) dated 22.08.2001 & SO No.1041(E) dated 16.10.2001 to introduce High Security Registration Plate System in India and also in pursuance of the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in writ petition no.510/2005, the Administrator, Union Territory Chandigarh is pleased to make the following scheme for the implementation of the High Security Registration Plates in the Union Territory of Chandigarh namely :-

1. This scheme shall be called "The Implementation of the High Security Registration Plates in the Union Territory of Chandigarh Scheme, 2011."
2. The Scheme shall come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August, 2011, in case of new vehicles.
3. As far as already registered old vehicles are concerned, the task of implementing this scheme


will be completed within two years from the above mentioned date.

4. Under this scheme, after the Registering & Licensing Authority has issued registration number for a vehicle, the vehicle owner shall procure High Security Registration Plates for the vehicle from any of the vendors eligible under the Motor Vehicles (New High Security Registration Plates) Order, 2001, having "Type Approval Certificate" issued by any of the testing agencies authorized by Government of India.
5. In the case of three and four wheelers, a Third Registration Plate in the form of a self-destructive type sticker shall also be affixed on the windshield of the vehicle. This shall also be procured by the vehicle owner from the authorized vendor as mentioned in the preceding Para No.4
6. The vehicle owner shall thereafter bring a person to the office of Registering and Licensing Authority for fastening of the High Security Registration Plates and for affixing the Third Registration Plate (if required as in Para No. 5 above) to the vehicle.

7. The High Security Registration Plates (including the Third Registration Plate if required as per Para No.5) shall be fastened / affixed on the vehicle within the premises of the Registering & Licensing Authority in the presence of Registering and Licensing Authority or his authorized representative.
8. Only after the High Security Registration Plates are fastened/affixed to the vehicle and the vehicle is found fit to ply on road, Registration Certificate shall be given to the vehicle owner.
9. Non-compliance will invite action as provided under the provisions of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
10. The Scheme will be given wide publicity in the print as well as electronic media, more than once, in order to keep the vehicle owners informed of what they are supposed to do for its effective implementation.
11. The Chandigarh Administration will maintain a Digitized record of the data of all the High Security Registration Plates installed on the vehicles

registered with Registering & Licensing Authority,  
Chandigarh.

12. To achieve the objectives of Motor Vehicles (New High Security Registration Plates) Order, 2001 and Rule 50 of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989, the Chandigarh Administration may from time to time issue instructions to regulate the sale of High Security Registration Plates for the vehicles registered with Registering & Licensing Authority, Chandigarh, in the ambit of this policy and the rules.


